Packing List

All riders are responsible for packing their own trunks by noon on the day the horses are hauling to the horse show. Ideally, this is done the night/day before so everything is ready to go with no stress! Riders must make sure that everything on this list is clean, well-fitting, and in good working order.

Paperwork:

- Copies of memberships
- Emergency directives
- Checkbook/wallet/I.D.
- Stall Card

For Travel:

- Shipping boots or wraps
- Cooler (depending on season)
- Leather halter
- Lead rope

For You:

- Sunblock
- Sunglasses
- Hat or cap
- Comfortable clothes/shoes for after competition
- Beverages and snacks
- Aspirin, Band-Aids
- Cell phone

Show Apparel:

- Breeches
- Boots
- Boot socks
- Boot polish
- Spurs
- Coat
- Show shirt (one for every day)
- Helmet
- Hair net and hair ties
- Gloves
- Belt

For Grooming:

- Brushes, curries
- Hoof pick
- Sponges and rags
- Grooming tote
- Braiding kit
- Scissors
- Tail bandage (if tail is being braided)
- sleezy

For Your Horse:

- Bridle
- Bit
- Saddle and cover
- Half pad
- Schooling saddle pad
- Show saddle pad
- Girth
- Boots and/or polos
- Martingales or other auxiliary tack
- Breast plate if needed
- Whip/crop
- Stud chain for locking stall
- Stable sheet for night
- Treats
- Standing bandages and quilts
- Pre-bagged grain

Shared Supplies

- Wheelbarrow
- 2+ pitchforks
- Water buckets (3 per horse)
- Bridle and saddle racks
- Stall drapes
- Furniture for set up
- Hay
- Halter nameplates
- Leather cleaner
